NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Real Estate Appraiser Qualifications and Ethics Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 101 at 2 p.m. Central on Friday, July 14, 2017, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0040 in the Attorney General's Old Conference Room on the 17<sup>th</sup> Floor.

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to comply with federal and state laws concerning appraisal management companies. The proposed amendment addresses licensure requirements. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
