NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Board of Integrative Health Care will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 112 at 3 p.m central time, on Friday, January 13, 2017, at Office of Attorney General, 17th Floor, Old Conference Room, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to implement statutes concerning acupuncture licensure. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
