NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND AND REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES
RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF THE 2018 NORTH DAKOTA PLUMBING CODE
BASED ON THE 2018 UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Plumbing Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code, Title 62, State Board of Plumbing, Article 62-03.1 Plumbing Installation Standards, Chapter 62-03.1-01 Administration, Section 62-03.1-01-01 Conformance With Uniform Plumbing Code, Section 62-03.1-01-04 Administrative Powers and Duties and Section 62-03.1-01-05 Application for Plumbing Installation Certificates; and Chapter 62-03.1-02, Section 62-03.1-02-01 Conformance with other regulations; and repeal Chapter 62-03.1-02 General Regulations, Section 62-03.1-02-02 Uniform Plumbing Code – Exceptions and Modifications at 1:00 p.m. on 25th day of June, 2019, at Bank of North Dakota, 1200 Memorial Highway, Leadership Hall – Room 201, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments and repeal is to adopt by reference the 2018 North Dakota Plumbing Code based on the 2018 Uniform Plumbing Code. The proposed amendments to Section 62-03.1-01-01 changes the name of the plumbing code, subsection 1 implements the adoption of the new plumbing code and subsection 2 changes the name of the plumbing code; the proposed amendment to Section 62-03.1-01-04 changes the name of the plumbing code; the proposed amendments to Section 62-03.1-01-05 and subsection 2 implements the addition and use of electronic certificates; and the proposed amendment to 62-03-1-02-01 corrects a typographical error; and the proposed repeal of Section 62-03.1-02-02 removes the exceptions and modifications because they will now be addressed throughout the body of the proposed 2018 North Dakota Plumbing Code. The proposed adoption, amendments and repeal is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
