## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Seed Department will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 74, chapter 74-03-01 (General Seed Certification Requirements); chapter 74-03-02 (Specific Crop Requirements-Small Grains), chapter 74-03-09 (Specific Crop Requirements-Mustard, Crambe, Canola, and Rape); chapter 74-03-11 (Specific Crop Requirements- Sunflower); chapter 74-03-14 (Specific Crop Requirements-Hybrid Wheat and Hybrid Rye); chapter 74-03- (Specific Crop Requirements-Industrial Hemp); new chapter 74-03-1 (Specific Crop Requirements-Faba Beans); chapter 74-04-01 (Seed Potato Certification Standards) at 10:00 am on February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the North Dakota State Seed Department, 1313 18<sup>th</sup> St. N., Fargo, ND 58105. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to update and revise outdated rules in administrative code. The proposed adoption addresses implementation of one new crop specific chapter. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the ND State Seed Department, 1313 18<sup>th</sup> St. N., Fargo, ND 58105.
