## NOTICE OF INTENT TO [ADOPT, AMEND OR REPEAL] **ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Electrical Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code Article 24.1 at 8:30 a.m. on July 26, 2017, at the North Dakota State Electrical Board, 1929 N Washington Street, Suite A-1, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to implement statutes. The proposed amendments address:

- 24.1-03-01-05: Clarifies the intent of apprentice electrician training as defined by NDCC 43-09-11(2)(b)(1).
- 24.1-05-01-01(2): Modifies minimum job cost amount to conform with NDCC 43-09-05, which takes effect August 1, 2017.
- 24.1-05-01-02(4): Updates fee schedule to conform with NDCC 43-09-05, which takes effect August 1, 2017.

The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.00.

The proposed amendments may be reviewed at the office of the N.D. State Electrical Board, 1929 N. Washington Street, Suite A-1, Bismarck, North Dakota 58507. A copy of the proposed amendments and/or a regulatory analysis may be requested by writing the above address or calling (701) 328-9522. Written or oral comments on the proposed amendments sent to the above address or telephone number and received by August 7, 2017 will be fully considered.
