## **Item Description**

**One-time funding** - The Legislative Assembly identified a total of \$5,003,327 from the general fund, of which \$3,910,827 relates to the legislative applications replacement system computer project, \$92,500 to computer equipment replacement, and \$1 million to legislative wing equipment and improvements. This amount is not to be considered part of the agency's base budget for the 2011-13 biennium, and the Legislative Assembly is to report to the Appropriations Committees during the 2011 legislative session on the use of this funding.

## Status/Result

The following is a summary of the status of the Legislative Assembly's one-time funding:

Computer equipment replacement	The computer equipment is anticipated to be purchased during the second year of the biennium.	
Legislative wing equipment and improvements	As of March 31, 2010, the Legislative Assembly has spent \$311,933 of the legislative wing equipment and improvements funding.
