 transfer up to \$8 million from the current earnings and the accumulated undivided profits of the Bank of North Dakota to the
 health information technology loan fund to meet any required match for federal funds or to the electronic health information
 exchange fund to meet any required match for federal funds or as directed, a portion to both funds to meet any required match for
 federal funds.
- If actual general fund revenues for the period July 1, 2009, through September 30, 2009, exceed estimated general fund revenues for that period by at least \$22.5 million, as determined by the Office of Management and Budget, based on the legislative estimates made at the close of the 2009 legislative session and upon certification by the Health Information Technology Office director to the director of the Office of Management and Budget of a demonstrated need for health information technology planning loans, the Industrial Commission is to transfer up to \$5 million from the current earnings and the accumulated undivided profits of the Bank of North Dakota to the health information technology planning loan fund.
