

Section 8 of 2009 Senate Bill No. 2020 authorized the State Board of Higher Education to adjust FTE positions as needed. A total of 1.65 FTE positions were removed pursuant to this section and reported to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for a total of 52.3 FTE positions.

Other Sections in Bill

Additional income appropriation - Section 3 provides that in addition to the amount appropriated as other funds any other income received from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute, is appropriated for the purposes designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2011-13 biennium.

FTE position adjustments - Section 5 authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase FTE positions for the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute and report any adjustments to OMB.

Unexpended general fund authority - Excess income - Section 6 authorizes the continuation of any unspent general fund appropriation authority and excess income received by the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute into the 2013-15 biennium.
