## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND, REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Public Employees Retirement System will hold a public hearing to address proposed new rules, amendments to, and repeal of N.D.A.C. Articles 71-01, 71-02, 71-03, 71-04, 71-05, and 71-08. The proposed rulemaking implements House Bill 1040 enacted during the 2023 regular legislative session relating to the closure of the North Dakota Public Employees Retirement System (NDPERS) main plan, the deferred compensation program, and expansion of the defined contribution retirement plan; HB 1547 enacted during the 2023 special legislative session relating to the membership of the public employees retirement system board; and rules relating to procedure for completing and filing petitions, special elections, conversion of sick leave, disability benefits, insurance enrollment, continuation of life insurance after retirement, premium billing, employee contribution, deferred compensation enrollment and deferral changes. The hearing will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Monday, April 29, 2024, in the NDPERS Conference Room at 1600 East Century Avenue, Suite 2, Bismarck, North Dakota. The hearing will continue until 12:00 P.M. or until no further testimony is offered, whichever occurs last. The proposed rules may be viewed online at
