all servicemen who have been on continuous active duty since August 5, 1964, would be eligible for 107 months of domestic service. This would amount to \$1337.50 based on a rate of \$12.50 per month.  In order for these individuals to be affected by a \$1600.00 maximum, they would have to be eligible for at least 53 months of foreign service. This figure is based on additional payment of \$5.00 for each month of overseas time.  Our office is unable to estimate the number of servicemen who may be eligible for more than \$1600.00 because we cannot determine the amount of foreign service a serviceman is eligible for until a cessation date is set and their overseas time has been verified.  We are also unable to estimate the number of eligible servicemen who have been on

continuous active duty since August 5, 1964, many of them may be officers who cannot apply until a cessation date is set. Officers serve for an indefinite period.
