House Bill 1230 is a bill to repay the Presidential Disaster Fund for the Individual
and Family Grant programs that were conducted in North Dakota as a result of the
spring flood of 1975, the severe storm and summer flood of 1975, and the spring
flood of 1976.
All the money received by the division of Disaster Emergency Services from the
Federal government has been allocated to the counties (see attachmentshows the
amount each county received).
The program was put into effect by the Governor at the request of the local political
subdivisions (counties). The program called for a 75% Federal and 25% state or local
match. If at the time of the disaster the State or its political subdivision lacked
their 25% share, the State can request 100% from the Federal government. Then, the
State, at its first opportunity, must ask its Legislature to repay its 25% share of the
program. Therefore, House Bill 1230 is an attempt by the State to request its Legisla-
ture to repay its share of a program already administered.
