With the additional duties placed upon the secretary of state's office as proposed by H.B. 1229, we estimate approximately \$2,000 will be needed to implement the act.

The bill proposes that the secretary of state prescribe all statement forms that need to be filed in the various offices. The forms are to be filed with the county auditor of the candidates county of residence or in the office of the secretary of state, depending on the office.

The bill charges the secretary of state to annually audit statements filed by any state committee of any political party or any political committee on behalf of any candidate for governor. The secretary of state is to audit not less than ten percent random sampling of all statements filed according to the proposed bill also.

The additional duties placed on our office, we estimate that those duties will cost \$1,000 for composition, printing, and distribution of the necessary reporting forms. We also estimate that the cost of auditing the statements filed in this office will cost \$1,000 to set up the necessary system to do a thorough job.
