In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal. If additional space is needed, attach a supplementary sheet. (Please type)

This bill would expand the National Guard Tuition Waiver Program to include private colleges. It is not possible to give an exact dollar cost to the bill since it is unknown how many National Guardsmen would enroll in the two private colleges in the State. The costs would be paid for from the appropriation contained in House Bill 1139. 75 percent of the tuition cost of Mary College would be \$1273.00 per year, and \$1725.00 per year at Jamestown College. If proposed amendments to House Bill 1657 were adopted limiting payments for tuition for Guardsmen at those Colleges to the maximum paid at the State-operated college having the highest tuition and requiring a participating private college to waive 25 percent of the tuition in the same manner as State Colleges, the cost per Guardsman attending would be reduced to \$544.00 per student.
