In 1978 there were 31 commercial frog licenses sold for \$50.00 each, generating \$1,550.00 revenue. Twelve were sold to residents and 18 to nonresidents. If the same number of commercial frog licenses was sold under this Act, the revenue from the sale of commercial frog licenses would be \$2,550.00. The resident frog and resident family frog license could possibly generate another \$200.00. (25 x \$3 = \$75) (25 x \$5 = \$125). Since we have no past history of resident, or resident family frog licenses the income estimate for these licenses may be somewhat low. It should be noted that the sale of commercial frog licenses depends onthe demand for and availability of frogs. Some years only two or three licenses have been sold.
