This amendment to the fiscal note prepared 1-4-83 regarding HB 1044 reflects a decrease in the amount of revenue due to amendments to the original bill. Therefore, we estimate an increase in revenue for banks of \$162,388 over the present biennium of \$538,071 or \$700,459. This is a decrease of \$66,147 in estimated revenue for bank examinations.					
The estimated revenue for credit unions should remain the same as projected in the fiscal note.					
The present biennium credit union revenue is estimated at \$89,971 and projected revenue for the 1983-85 biennium is \$95,000 or an increase of \$5,029.
