Narrative:

HB 1552 allows the sale of beer and wine by concessionaires on property leased to the Parks and Recreation Department by the Corps of Engineers, provided the concessionaire also obtains appropriate local and state licenses required.

The estimated state general or special fund effect is zero or minimal at best. Each concession contract is independently agreed to by the party involved and the Parks and Recreation Department. The amount generated to the state general or special fund is determined by the total concession operation. HB 1552 allows for the possible provision of a service requested by the users that is estimated to have a zero or minimal impact on the total concession operations.
