The amount to be expended is dependent upon the number of extradition requests from county law enforcement agencies. During the 1983-1985 biennium, \$63,924 was expended In the current biennium \$34,560 was appropriated with \$37,816 being spent to date with other requests for payment pending. This bill will place limits on classes of payment requests to ensure that this fund will continue to be available to all county requests in the next biennium.
OMB has proposed that this item be placed within the Attorney General's budget and appropriation. The Governor's budget recommends $$69,120$ for arrest and return of fugitives.
Historically, requests for payments have exceeded the appropriation. Emergency Commission approval of otherwise proper individual requests for payment will not be necessary should this fund be at a level to meet anticipated requests.
