Narrative: REVENUE:

Raises the annual gaming license fee to \$150 from the present \$100 fee for those organizations that have annual average gross proceeds exceeding \$25,000.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$35,000.

Licenses manufacturers of paper bingo cards at an annual license fee of \$2,000.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$12,000.

Increases the annual license fee to \$1,500 from the present \$1,000 fee for gaming distributors.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$11,000.

Increases the annual license fee to \$2,000 from the present \$250 fee for manufacturers of games of charitable gaming tickets.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$32,000.

Enables the attorney general to charge licensed distributors up to twenty five cents for each state gaming stamp.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$50,000.
