The bill sets a limit on site rental, eliminates the games of paper charitable gaming tickets except when conducted through electronic mechanical dispensing devices, and requires manufacturing standards, testing and approval of devices, and a computer telecommunications and management information system. The bill allocates adjusted gross proceeds between gaming tax, expenses, and eligible uses, requires licensing of manufacturers, distributors, and video devices, and requires background investigations of applicants.
