THIS BILL WOULD CONTINUE THE TRIGGER TAX MECHANISM THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1997. UNDER THE TRIGGER MECHANISM, EACH TRIGGERED CENT PROVIDES (PER BIENNIUM) 5.4 MILLION DOLLARS FOR THE STATE, 2 MILLION DOLLARS FOR THE COUNTIES, AND 1.2 MILLION DOLLARS FOR THE CITIES.
