	This bill permits transfers of the assistant attorneys general (AAG's) performing legal work for the Department of Transportation, Department of Human Services, and Workers' Compensation Bureau from the Office of Attorney General to those agencies. The Insurance Department currently employs its own AAG's, as do the Tax Department, Public Service Commission, and North Dakota University Systems, which are not mentioned
	in this bill. Since the legal service billing revenues substantially exceed the cost of the these 10 AAG's the General Fund will be adversely impacted. In addition, these agencies currently use the equivalent of only 9.0 AAG's services, since these AAG's are assigned to perform other legal services. Because it's not possible to transfer only part of a person the AAG equivalents were rounded up, and the equivalent of 1.0 additional AAG is transferred from the Attorney General's office.
