AN ACT to amend and reenact section 12.1-35-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to limits on child testimony.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-35-04 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12.1-35-04. Limits on interviews <u>and testimony</u>. The prosecuting attorney, <u>the court</u>, and appropriate law enforcement personnel shall, to the extent possible, <u>shall</u> protect the victim or witness from the psychological damage of repeated or lengthy <u>interrogation</u> <u>interview</u>, <u>testimony</u>, or discovery proceedings while preserving the rights of the public, the victim, and the person charged with the violation.
