BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 3 of section 54-52-17 of the 8 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 9 Normal retirement date, except for a national guard security officer or a. 10 firefighter, is: 11 (1) The first day of the month next following the month in which the 12 member attains the age of sixty-five years; or 13 (2) When the member has a combined total of years of service credit and 14 years of age equal to eighty-eight eighty-five and has not received a 15 retirement benefit under this chapter. 16 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subdivisions a and e of subsection 4 of section 54-52-17 17 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as 18 follows: 19 Normal retirement benefits for all retirees, except supreme and district court a.

monthly, comprised of a service benefit and a prior service benefit, as defined

1 Service benefit equals one and seventy-four seventy-seven hundredths (1) 2 percent of final average salary multiplied by the number of years of 3 service employment. 4 (2) Prior service benefit equals one and seventy-four seventy-seven 5 hundredths percent of final average salary multiplied by the number of 6 years of prior service employment. 7 (3)All participants who retired before January 1, 1994 August 1, 1997, are 8 entitled to benefits calculated at one and seventy-four seventy-seven 9 hundredths percent of final average salary, multiplied by the number of 10 years of service employment, with the increased benefits payable 11 beginning January 1, 1994 August 1, 1997. 12 e. Disability retirement benefits are twenty-five percent of the member's final 13 average salary. The minimum monthly disability retirement benefit under this 14 section is one hundred dollars. A participant who, on July 31, 1997, is 15 receiving disability retirement benefits that are not based upon the benefit 16 multiplier is entitled to receive an increase in benefits equal to five percent of 17 the individual's present benefit with the increased benefits payable beginning 18 August 1, 1997. 19 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-52-17.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is 20 amended and reenacted as follows: 21 **54-52-17.5.** Postretirement adjustments. An individual who, on June 30, 1989 22 July 31, 1997, is receiving retirement benefits under this chapter is entitled to receive an 23 increase in benefits equal to five and seventy six hundredths three percent of the individual's 24 present benefits with the increase payable beginning August 1, 1997. 25 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-52-17.10 of the 1995 Supplement to the North 26 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 27 54-52-17.10. Prior service retiree adjustment. Prior service retirees who are 28 receiving benefits under this chapter on December 31, 1993 July 31, 1997, are entitled to 29 receive an increase in benefits equal to ene five percent of the individual's present benefit, with the increased benefits payable beginning January 1, 1994 August 1, 1997.
