- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to payments for refugee students having limited English language skills;

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 created and enacted as follows:

Per student payments - Limited English proficient refugee students.

- In addition to any other payments provided for by this chapter, each school district
 is entitled to receive three hundred dollars for each student who:
- a. Has immigrated to the United States as a refugee from a country in which a
 language other than English is dominant; and
- b. Has been assessed by the student's school district and determined to have
 negligible or very limited English language skills as evidenced by a
 classification of level I or II using the Woodcock-Munoz language survey.

 2. In order to receive the full payment provided for in this section, a school district
 must complete the student assessment required by subsection 1 and forward the
 results to the superintendent of public instruction on or before October first of each
 school year. The superintendent shall distribute the payments no later than May
 thirtieth of each school year. The superintendent shall prorate payments under
 this section for any students registering in the school district after October first or
 departing the school district prior to the completion of the school year.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$300,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the Fifty-fifth Legislative Assembly
