- 1. This Act does not affect an action or proceeding commenced before this Act takes effect.
- 2. If a security interest in a security is perfected at the date this Act takes effect and the action by which the security interest was perfected would suffice to perfect a security interest under this Act, no further action is required to continue perfection. If a security interest in a security is perfected at the date this Act takes effect but the action by which the security interest was perfected would not suffice to perfect a security interest was perfected at the security interest remains perfected for a period of four months after the effective date and continues perfected thereafter if appropriate action to perfect at the date this Act is taken within that period.
