## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1078

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-07.1 of the North Dakota Century  
2 Code, relating to waterfowl hunting by nonresidents; and to provide an expiration date.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the  
5 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required.** Except as provided  
7 in section 20.1-03-07.2, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that person first obtains a  
8 nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license.  
9 The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl, except  
10 geese, in the same manner as residents and to hunt dark or light geese for any period of  
11 fourteen consecutive days or any two periods of seven consecutive days each and in specified  
12 ~~waterfowl~~ goose hunting zones. A license authorizing two 7-day goose hunting periods may  
13 allow goose hunting in a different zone during each period. The governor, in the governor's  
14 proclamation, shall specify various ~~waterfowl~~ goose hunting zones for which nonresident  
15 waterfowl hunting licenses will be available, and may specify the number of licenses which may  
16 be issued in each zone and the manner in which they are to be issued. A nonresident is  
17 entitled to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year.

18 **SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through December 31, 1998,  
19 and after that date is ineffective.
