1 A BILL for an Act relating to lifeguard qualifications and equipment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 3 **SECTION 1. Definitions.** As used in this Act, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - "National organization" means an entity that meets the standards of the American red cross, the national safety council, or the American heart association and provides a training program generally available nationwide to persons fifteen years of age and older in the areas of lifeguarding, first aid, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
 - 2. "Swimming facility" means a natural or manmade body of water that is available to the members of the public for recreational purposes and for which lifeguarding services are provided by the owner or operator.
 - **SECTION 2.** Lifeguard Qualifications. An individual employed as a lifeguard in this state must hold current certifications in lifeguarding, first aid, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation issued by a national organization.
- SECTION 3. Lifeguard Equipment. The owner or operator of a swimming facility shall maintain in a location readily accessible by the lifeguard:
 - A first-aid kit containing items that are specifically used in the American red cross community first aid and safety course and American red cross and national safety council lifeguard training courses;
- 20 2. One spine board with a minimum of three straps;
- 21 3. One rescue tube or rescue can for each lifeguard on duty;
- 4. Cold packs or ice; and
- 5. One blanket.
