1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 27-20 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to school personnel notification of juvenile offenses; and to amend and

3 reenact subsection 4 of section 27-20-51 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to school

4 personnel receipt of juvenile orders of disposition or adjudications.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 27-20-51 of the 1995 Supplement 7 to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

13			<u>(1)</u>	The offense would constitute a felony were it committed by an adult;
14			<u>(2)</u>	The offense was committed on school property;

16			<u>(4)</u>	The offense was related to the use, possession, purchase, or trafficking
17				of marijuana, narcotic drugs, or other controlled substances; or
18			<u>(5)</u>	The offense involved the use or possession of a dangerous weapon;
19		<u>b.</u>	<u>Notify</u>	the juvenile's parents or guardian, in writing, when an order has been
20			<u>forwa</u>	rded as required by this subsection;
21		<u>C.</u>	Notify	the juvenile's school principal or chief administrative officer that,
22			notwit	thstanding any other provision of this section, the principal or officer may
23			<u>obtair</u>	additional information about the proceeding from the supervisor after
24			inform	ning the juvenile's parent or guardian; and

2			juvenile graduates from high school or reaches the age of twenty-three.					
3	3 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 27-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is							
4	created and enacted as follows:							
5 Notification of school officials regarding juvenile offenses.								
6	<u>1.</u>	A law enforcement officer shall notify a child's school principal or chief						
7		<u>adn</u>	ninistrative officer upon filing a petition with the juvenile court alleging that the					
8		child committed an offense:						
9		<u>a.</u>	Against a person;					
10		<u>b.</u>	Involving the use, possession, purchase, or trafficking of marijuana, narcotic					
11			drugs, or other controlled substances; or					
12		<u>C.</u>	Involving the use or possession of a dangerous weapon.					
13	<u>2.</u>	<u>a.</u>	A child's school principal or chief administrative officer may share any					
14			information received under this section with other school or school district					
15			personnel if doing so is determined necessary to ensure the safety or					
16			well-being of the child or of other persons attending, employed by, or					
17			otherwise involved with the child's school or school district.					
18		<u>b.</u>	The superintendent of public instruction may provide forms and guidelines for					
19			the sharing of information under this subsection.
