1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-40.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the rate of school district tuition payments.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 3

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-40.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 15-40.2-03. Tuition payments.

- 7 Except as provided in section 15-40.2-04, a school districts district educating 1. 8 pupils a student in other another school districts district shall pay the full cost of 9 education incurred by tuition to the receiving district. The costs must be 10 determined on the basis of the district's full time equivalent rate of tuition must be 11 set by the receiving district. The rate may not exceed one hundred fifty percent of 12 the average per student cost of education in the receiving district.
- 13 <u>2.</u> Cost under this section must be based on average daily membership and must 14 may include only those annual expenditures from the general fund and annual 15 educational expenditures from all special funds; provided, that only those 16 expenditures permitted in determining the educational cost per pupil in under 17 section 15-40.1-06 may be included in determining the receiving district's current 18 operating expenses.
- 19 To the district's current operating expense for average per student cost at the 3. 20 kindergarten, elementary, or high school students level, as the case may be, 21 except for special education students where for whom the superintendent of public 22 instruction must determine a fair rental charge for each student for capital outlay 23 must be determined by the department of public instruction, there must be added 24 the statewide total of all school districts' annual expenditures from sinking and

1		interest funds, plus the statewide total of all school districts' annual tax receipts to
2		the building funds, including any amounts expended from school districts' general
3		funds for capital outlay, divided by the average daily membership of the state.
4	<u>4.</u>	From this the amount determined under subsection 3, the following must be
5		deducted for each individual pupil:
6	<del>1.</del>	a. Such State payments as are received for that pupil from state payments
7		received by the admitting district for that student, less the average amount per
8		North Dakota resident <del>pupil</del> <u>student</u> enrolled in the school district <del>realized</del>
9		from the amounts provided for in subsection 3 of section 15-40.1-06; and
10	<del>2.</del>	b. A credit applied for any school taxes paid to the admitting district by the
11		parent or guardian of the admitted pupil. The amount remaining is the tuition
12		charge for the individual pupil, and must be paid under this chapter student. If
13		the district of residence and the parent or guardian are both paying tuition, the
14		credit allowed under this section subdivision for taxes paid to the admitting
15		district by the parent or guardian must be credited to the district of residence
16		and the parent or guardian in proportion to the amount of tuition paid by each.
17	<u>5.</u>	Nothing contained in this chapter affects the right of a school district to charge and
18		collect such tuition as may be fixed by agreement from pupils on behalf of students
19		who are not residents of this state, in accordance with section 15-40.2-10.
