- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-12.2-16 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the duties and powers of the bee inspector.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT**. Section 4-12.2-16 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
- 5 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **4-12.2-16. Bee inspector Duties Powers.** Upon request, the bee inspector shall
- 7 provide inspection services to beekeepers, provide assistance in the location of bee colonies
- 8 for pollination purposes, facilitate the interstate movement of bees, promote improvements in
- 9 apicultural practices, and work with institutions of higher education to promote the apiary
- 10 industry. If the bee inspector or a deputy inspector receives a complaint from a beekeeper,
- 11 aerial sprayer, or farmer, the inspector may enter private property during reasonable hours to
- make an external inspection for the purpose of identifying a colony.
