- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-09-13.2 and 43-18-11.4 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to licensing requirements for plumbing inspectors and electrical
- 3 inspectors.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-09-13.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **43-09-13.2. Electrical inspectors License required Exception.** A person
- 8 employed by the state electrical board or a political subdivision to inspect electrical installations
- 9 must be licensed as a journeyman or master electrician. A person employed by a political
- 10 <u>subdivision to conduct electrical installation inspections must pass the journeyman electrician</u>
- 11 examination administered by the board and be certified as an electrical inspector by either the
- 12 international conference of building officials or the international association of electrical
- 13 inspectors. The board may not require a person employed by a political subdivision to conduct
- 14 electrical installation inspections to serve any particular length of time as an electrician prior to
- 15 administering the journeyman examination. This section does not apply to an inspector
- 16 employed by the electrical board or a political subdivision as of July 2, 1989.
- 17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-18-11.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 18 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 **43-18-11.4. Plumbing inspectors License required Exception.** A person
- 20 employed by the state board of plumbing or a political subdivision to inspect plumbing
- 21 installations must be licensed as a journeyman or master plumber. A person employed by a
- 22 political subdivision to conduct plumbing inspections must pass the journeyman plumber
- 23 examination administered by the board and be certified as a plumbing inspector by the
- 24 international conference of building officials. Notwithstanding section 43-09-11, the board may

- 1 not require a person employed by a political subdivision to conduct plumbing inspections to
- 2 serve any particular length of time as a plumber before administering the journeyman
- 3 <u>examination.</u> This section does not apply to an inspector employed by the board of plumbing or
- 4 a political subdivision as of July 2, 1989.
