1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to continuing education of barbers; and to amend and reenact sections

3 43-04-07 and 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the state board of barber

4 examiners and fees.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 43-04-07. Compensation - Expenses - How paid. Each member of the board shall is 9 entitled to receive thirty dollars per day for actual services daily compensation for actual 10 services in an amount not to exceed sixty-two dollars and must also be paid his for actual 11 expenses, as provided by law, incurred in attending meetings of the board and in the 12 performance of his performing official duties. All funds collected or received by the board must 13 be deposited and disbursed in accordance with section 54-44-12. 14 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is 15 amended and reenacted as follows: 16 **43-04-42.** Fees. The fees to be paid by an applicant are as follows 17 1. The board may charge applicants the following fees: 18 For examination for and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, 1. a. 19 twenty one hundred dollars. 20 2. For issuance of such certificate, two dollars. 21 3. For examination for and issuance of a certificate to practice as an apprentice b. 22 barber, ten fifty dollars. 23 4. For issuance of such certificate, two dollars. 24 5. For renewal of a master barber's certificate, thirty-five fifty dollars. C.

2			fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.
3	7.	<u>e.</u>	For renewal of an apprentice barber's certificate, twenty dollars.
4	8.	<u>f.</u>	For restoration of an expired apprentice barber's certificate, a ten dollar
5			penalty fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.
6	9.	<u>g.</u>	For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one
7			hundred twenty-five dollars.
8	10.	<u>h.</u>	For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifteen thirty-five dollars, to be
9			paid by each shopowner in advance.
10	11.	<u>i.</u>	For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section
11			43-04-38.1, one hundred twenty-five dollars.
12	12.	j.	For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a ten dollar penalty fee in
13			addition to the annual license fee.
14	<u>2.</u>	Each application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be	
15		acc	companied by a fee of fifty dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must
16		be	retained by the board and deposited as other fees.
17	<u>3.</u>	Аc	duplicate license, certificate, or permit will must be issued upon the filing of:
18		<u>a.</u>	Filing a statement covering verified by the oath of the applicant which
19			explains the loss of the same, verified by the oath of the applicant, and
20			submitting;
21		<u>b.</u>	Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and the payment of
22		<u>C.</u>	Paying a fee of fifty cents ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate. The
23			board has the power to reduce renewal fees below the amounts heretofore
24			set out in this section whenever the board determines that the full amount is
25			not necessary to finance the necessary and regular operations of the board.
26			Such reduction must be made by the board only by applying an equal
27			percentage of reduction to all renewal fees provided for in this chapter, and
28			such reduction must be made when commencing the licensing year and is in
29			effect for the whole of such year.
30	<u>4.</u>	Any	one becoming who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United
31		Sta	tes in time of war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while

- in good standing as to payment of fees, may obtain a <u>certificate</u> restoration of his
 certificate without payment of the restoration fee.
- 3 SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 4 created and enacted as follows:

5	Con	ontinuing education requirements.		
6	<u>1.</u>	The board may adopt rules establishing requirements for the continuing education		
7		of persons licensed under this chapter.		
8	<u>2.</u>	The board may suspend, revoke, place on probationary status, or refuse to renew		
9		any license issued under this chapter if the licensee fails to meet the continuing		
10		education requirements established by the board.		
11	<u>3.</u>	An applicant for accreditation of continuing education courses, classes, or activities		
12		may be charged a reasonable fee determined by the board.
