- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the display of lighted headlamps.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-01 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **39-21-01. When lighted lamps are required.** Subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles, every vehicle upon a highway within this state must display lighted headlamps at all times while upon a highway that is outside the limits of a city or which has a speed limit of fifty-five miles [88.51 kilometers] an hour or higher and every vehicle upon a highway must display lighted lamps and illuminating devices as required in this chapter for different classes of vehicles as follows:
 - 1. At any time from sunset to sunrise, and every farm tractor upon a highway within this state at any time from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise;
 - At any time when it is raining, snowing, sleeting, or hailing or during other adverse
 driving conditions and these conditions do not render a person or vehicle on the
 highway clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet [304.8 meters]
 ahead; or
 - At any other time when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog, or other conditions, or when there is insufficient light to render a person or vehicle on the highway clearly discernible at a distance of one thousand feet [304.8 meters] ahead.
- 22 Stoplights, turn signals, and other signaling devices must be lighted as prescribed for the use of 23 such devices.
