- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the qualifications of school board members.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15-47-05. Qualifications of school electors and officers.
  - 1. Any person who is a qualified elector of this state is qualified:
    - <u>Qualified</u> to vote for the election of school officers in any the school district in which he is a resident, and is eligible to the person resides;
    - <u>b.</u> Eligible to be a member of the school board in any district in which the person resides or owns real property; provided, however, that a person may serve on only one school board at any one time;
    - <u>Eligible for</u> the office of business manager of the <u>a</u> school district, or member
      of the school board, or may; and
    - d. Eligible to be appointed as a judge or clerk of election. The business manager of the school district need not be a resident of the district in any district in which the person resides.
    - 2. For the purposes of elections held pursuant to chapter 15-28 enly, a person who resides on an air force base is a resident of a school district if the school district receives students from the air force base pursuant to contract and receives impact aid pursuant to Public Law 81-874, as amended [64 Stat. 1100; 20 U.S.C. 236 et seq.].
