HOUSE BILL NO. 1246 (Representatives Drovdal, R. Kelsch, Monson) (Senators Freborg, Goetz)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 15-40.1-07.6 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to special education per student payments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-40.1-07.6 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15-40.1-07.6. Per student payments - Special education.

- <u>1.</u> Each Except as provided in subsection 2, each biennium, the superintendent of public instruction shall distribute moneys appropriated by the legislative assembly for per student special education payments to each school district in the state on the basis of students in average daily membership. The superintendent of public instruction shall forward the payments, as calculated under subsection 3 of section 15-40.1-06, to eligible school districts in the same manner and at the same time that the superintendent distributes foundation aid payments. For purposes of this section, "special education" means the provision of special services to students who have special needs, including students who are gifted and talented. Expenditures under this section may not conflict with nonsupplanting and maintenance of effort provisions under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq.
- 2. The superintendent of public instruction may, upon the written request of a school district, forward all or a portion of the moneys for which the school district is eligible under this section directly to the special education unit of which the school district is a member.
