4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Administrative rulemaking restricted - Administrative rules committee study.

- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an agency may not adopt an
 administrative rule in the manner provided in chapter 28-32 unless the rule falls
 within an area in which the agency has been specifically required to adopt rules by
 state law or federal law, regulations, or rules.
- 2. During the 1997-98 interim, the legislative council shall assign to the committee on administrative rules a study of the statutory authority of each agency with administrative rulemaking authority and the rules that have been adopted under that authority, with the directive that the committee should seek to limit administrative rulemaking authority to areas in which the legislative assembly or federal law has specifically required rulemaking.
- SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through July 31, 1999, and is thereafter ineffective.
