SENATE BILL NO. 2184 (Senators W. Stenehjem, Holmberg) (Representatives Kretschmar, Stenehjem)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to campaign contribution statements required of persons promoting passage or defeat of initiated or referred measures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

2. A person soliciting or accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding the circulation of a statewide initiative or referred measure may not accept a contribution of more than one hundred dollars from an individual a person who does not reside in this state or from an out-of-state political committee unless the contribution is accompanied by a certified statement from the contributor listing the name, address, and amount contributed by each person who contributed more than one hundred dollars of the contribution. If no person contributed in excess of one hundred dollars from the out-of-state person's or political committee's overall contribution, the statement must indicate that fact. The certified statement must also list the occupation, employer, and principal place of business for each person who contributed more than two one hundred dollars of the contribution. The person soliciting or accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding the circulation of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or of promoting passage or defeat of a statewide initiated or referred measure must include this statement with the contribution statement required to be filed under subsection 1.
