- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 48-02-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to bonds required of contractors for certain public improvement contracts; and to
- 3 declare an emergency.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 48-02-06.2 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
 - Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **48-02-06.2. Bonds from contractors for public improvements.** A governing body,
- 8 as defined in section 48-01.1-01, authorized to enter into a contract for construction of a public
- 9 improvement in excess of one hundred thousand dollars shall take from the contractor a bond
- 10 before permitting any work to be done on that contract. The bond must be for an amount equal
- 11 at least to the price stated in the contract. The bond must be conditioned to be void if the
- 12 contractor and all subcontractors fully perform all terms, conditions, and provisions of the
- 13 contract and pay all bills or claims on account of labor and materials including supplies used for
- 14 machinery and equipment, performed, furnished, and used in the performance of the contract,
- 15 including all demands of subcontractors. The requirement that bills and claims be paid must
- 16 include the requirement that interest of the amount authorized under section 13-01-14 be paid
- 17 on bills and claims not paid within ninety days. The bond is security for all bills, claims, and
- 18 demands until fully paid, with preference to labor and material suppliers as to payment. The
- 19 bond must run to the governing body, but any person having a lawful claim against the
- 20 contractor, or any subcontractor, as provided in this chapter, may sue on the bond.
- 21 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
