- 1 A BILL for an Act relating to liability for damage or injury caused by dogs running at large; and
2 to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. Dogs running at large - Liability for damage or injury.** The owner of a
5 dog may not permit the dog to run at large. The owner of a dog is liable for any damage to the
6 property of another person and for any injury to any individual caused by the owner's dog
7 running at large, as well as for any costs incurred by a local law enforcement agency in
8 capturing and impounding the owner's dog. If the owner of a dog is a minor, the duties and
9 responsibilities created by this section are imputed to the parent or legal guardian of the minor.

10 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
