1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-20 of the North Dakota 2 Century Code, relating to prohibiting the facilitation of sexual acts in public; and to provide a 3 penalty. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows: 7 Facilitation of sexual acts in public. 8 As used in this section: 1. "Adult entertainment center" means any commercial facility at which motion 9 10 pictures or videos that include explicit representations of sexual conduct are 11 offered for viewing at that facility, but does not include the guest rooms of a 12 hotel or motel. 13 b. "Sexual act" has the meaning prescribed in section 12.1-20-02. 14 "Sexual conduct" has the meaning prescribed in section 12.1-27.1-01. c. 15 2. It is an infraction for a person to willfully own, rent, lease, manage, or exercise 16 control of any portion of an adult entertainment center if that portion contains: 17 a. Any partition between subdivisions of a room or area that has an opening, 18 commonly known as a glory hole, that facilitates a sexual act between individuals on either side of the partition; or 19 20 A room, booth, stall, or partitioned portion of a room offered to individuals for b. 21 a fee as an incident to viewing a video, motion picture, or similar 22 entertainment, unless the room, booth, stall, or partitioned portion of the room
