1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 62.1-04 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to reciprocity for concealed weapons licenses; and to amend and
3 reenact subsection 3 of section 62.1-02-10, subdivision a of subsection 2 of section 62.1-03-01,
4 and section 62.1-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to concealed weapons
5 licenses.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 62.1-02-10 of the North Dakota
8 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

9 3. Any person possessing a valid North Dakota concealed weapons license; or a
10 valid license issued by another state authorizing the person to carry a dangerous
11 weapon concealed if that state permits a holder of a valid North Dakota concealed
12 weapons license to carry a dangerous weapon concealed in that state without
13 obtaining a similar license from that state, except while that person is in the field
14 engaged in hunting or trapping activities.

15 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 2 of section 62.1-03-01 of the
16 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

17 a. Any person possessing a valid North Dakota concealed weapons license or a
18 valid license issued by another state authorizing the person to carry a
19 dangerous weapon concealed if that state permits a holder of a valid North
20 Dakota concealed weapons license to carry a dangerous weapon concealed
21 in that state without obtaining a similar license from that state.

22 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 62.1-04-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
23 amended and reenacted as follows:

1 **62.1-04-04. Producing license on demand.** Every person while carrying a concealed
2 firearm or dangerous weapon for which a license to carry concealed is required, shall have on
3 one's person the license issued by this or another state and shall give it to any law enforcement
4 officer for an inspection upon demand by the officer. The failure of any person to give the
5 license to the officer is prima facie evidence that the person is illegally carrying a firearm or
6 dangerous weapon concealed.

7 **SECTION 4.** A new section to chapter 62.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
8 created and enacted as follows:

9 **Reciprocity.** A person who has a valid license issued by another state to carry a
10 concealed firearm or dangerous weapon in that state and whose state grants to residents of
11 this state the right to carry a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon without requiring a
12 separate license to carry a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon issued by that state may
13 carry, subject to the provisions of this state's law, a concealed firearm or dangerous weapon in
14 this state, and the other state's license is valid in this state.
