1 A BILL for an Act to provide for limitations on the possession and sale of hypodermic syringes

2 and needles; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. Possession and sale of hypodermic syringes and needles - Penalty. 5 A person may not possess, control, manufacture, sell, furnish, dispense, or otherwise dispose 6 of hypodermic syringes or needles or any instrument or implement that can be adapted for 7 subcutaneous injections, except for the following persons when acting in the course of their 8 practice or employment: licensed practitioners, registered pharmacies and their employees or 9 agents, licensed pharmacists, licensed doctors of veterinary medicine and their assistants, 10 registered nurses, registered medical technologists, medical interns, licensed drug wholesales 11 and their employees or agents, licensed hospitals, licensed nursing homes, bona fide hospitals 12 where animals are treated, licensed funeral directors, syringe and needle manufacturers and 13 their dealers and agents, persons engaged in animal husbandry, clinical laboratories, persons 14 engaged in bona fide research or education or industrial use of hypodermic syringes and 15 needles provided these persons cannot use hypodermic syringes and needles for the 16 administration of drugs to human beings unless the drugs are prescribed, dispensed, and 17 administered by a person lawfully authorized to do so, and persons who administer drugs 18 pursuant to an order or direction of a licensed physician. A violation of this section is an infraction. 19
