SENATE BILL NO. 2339 (Senators Lips, Tallackson) (Representatives Kerzman, Skarphol)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 57-06-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the property tax exemption for carbon dioxide pipelines.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-06-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

57-06-17.1. Carbon dioxide pipeline exemption. Property, not including land, is exempt from taxation <u>during construction and</u> for the first ten full taxable years after commencement of construction following initial operation if it consists of a pipeline, constructed after 1996 and necessary associated equipment for the transportation or storage of carbon dioxide to an oilfield in this state for use in enhanced recovery of oil or natural gas.
