A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 5 of article V of the Constitution of North 1

2 Dakota, relating to the election of executive branch officers.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

4 This amendment provides that one-half of the elected state officials will be chosen by voters in

5 each election year. To start this arrangement, the agriculture commissioner, attorney general,

6 secretary of state, and tax commissioner will be elected for two-year terms in 2000 and

7 thereafter will be elected to four-year terms.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF 9

REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

10 That the following proposed amendment to section 5 of article V of the Constitution of 11 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at 12 the primary election to be held in 1998, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota. 13

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 5 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota 14 15 is amended and reenacted as follows:

16 Section 5. The qualified electors shall choose the elected state officials at a time 17 designated by the legislative assembly. The elected state officials shall serve until their 18 successors are duly qualified. Terms of office of the elected officials except the public service 19 commissioners are four years, except that the term of the agriculture commissioner, attorney 20 general, secretary of state, and tax commissioner elected in 2000 must be for two years. The 21 terms of the public service commissioners are six years, so arranged that one of them is 22 elected every two years. The terms of the governor and lieutenant governor begin on 23 December fifteenth following their election.

- 1 If two or more candidates for any executive office other than for governor and lieutenant
- 2 governor receive an equal and highest number of votes, the legislative assembly in joint
- 3 session shall choose one of them for the office.
