7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

- 8 **REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**
- 9 That the following proposed amendments to subsection 1 of section 6 of article VIII and 10 sections 12 and 13 of article IX of the Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and must be 11 submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general election to be held in 1998, in 12 accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.
- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 6 of article VIII of the Constitution
 of North Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 1. A <u>The state</u> board of higher education, to be officially known as the state board of
- 16 higher education, is hereby created for the shall control and administration of
- 17 <u>administer</u> the following state educational institutions, to wit:
- 18 a. The state university and school of mines, at Grand Forks, with their
 19 substations.
- 20 b. The state agricultural college and experiment station, at Fargo, with their
 21 substations.
- 22 c. The school of science, at Wahpeton.
- 23 d. The state normal schools and teachers colleges, at Valley City, Mayville,
 24 Minot, and Dickinson.
- 25 e. The school of forestry, at Bottineau.

3	SE	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 12 of article IX of the Constitution of North	
4	Dakota is a	mended and reenacted as follows:	
5	Sec	tion 12. The following public institutions of the state are permanently located at the	
6	places here	einafter named, each to have the lands specifically granted to it by the United States	
7	in the Act of Congress approved February 22, 1889, to be disposed of and used in such		
8	manner as the legislative assembly may prescribe subject to the limitations provided in the		
9	article on school and public lands contained in this constitution.		
10	1.	The seat of government at the city of Bismarck in the county of Burleigh.	
11	2.	The state university and the school of mines at the city of Grand Forks, in the	
12		county of Grand Forks.	
13	3.	The North Dakota state university of agriculture and applied science at the city of	
14		Fargo, in the county of Cass.	
15	4.	A state normal school at the city of Valley City, in the county of Barnes, and the	
16		legislative assembly, in apportioning the grant of eighty thousand acres of land for	
17		normal schools made in the Act of Congress referred to shall grant to the said	
18		normal school at Valley City, as aforementioned, fifty thousand (50,000) acres, and	
19		said lands are hereby appropriated to said institution for that purpose.	
20	5.	The school for the deaf and dumb of North Dakota at the city of Devils Lake , in the	
21		county of Ramsey.	
22	6. <u>3.</u>	A state training industrial school at the city of Mandan, in the county of Morton.	
23	7.	A state normal school at the city of Mayville, in the county of Traill, and the	
24		legislative assembly in apportioning the grant of lands made by Congress in the	
25		Act aforesaid for state normal schools shall assign thirty thousand (30,000) acres	
26		to the institution hereby located at Mayville, and said lands are hereby	
27		appropriated for said purpose.	
28	8. <u>4.</u>	A state hospital for the insane mentally ill at the city of Jamestown, in the county of	
29		Stutsman. And the The legislative assembly shall appropriate twenty thousand	
30		acres of the grant of lands made by the Act of Congress aforesaid for other

5		the secretary of the interior for a penitentiary building.	
6	SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 13 of article IX of the Constitution of North	
7	Dakota is a	mended and reenacted as follows:	
8	Sec	tion 13. The following public institutions are located as provided, each to have so	
9	much of the	e remaining grant of one hundred seventy thousand acres of land made by the	
10) United States for "other educational and charitable institutions" as is allotted by law:		
11	1.	A soldiers' veterans' home, when located, or such other charitable institution as the	
12		legislative assembly may determine, at the city of Lisbon in the county of Ransom,	
13		with a grant of forty thousand acres of land.	
14	2.	The school for the blind at the city of Grand Forks in the county of Grand Forks or	
15		at such other another location as may be determined by the legislative assembly to	
16		be in the best interests of the students of such the institution and the state of North	
17		Dakota .	
18	3.	A school of forestry, or such other institution as the legislative assembly may	
19		determine, at such place in one of the counties of McHenry, Ward, Bottineau, or	
20		Rolette, as the electors of said counties may determine by an election for that	
21		purpose, to be held as provided by the legislative assembly.	
22	4.	A school of science or such other educational or charitable institution as the	
23		legislative assembly may prescribe, at the city of Wahpeton in the county of	
24		Richland, with a grant of forty thousand acres.	
25	5.	A state college at the city of Minot in the county of Ward.	
26	6.	A state college at the city of Dickinson in the county of Stark.	
27	7.	A state hospital for the mentally ill at such a place within this state as shall be	
28		selected by the legislative assembly.	
29	No other institution of a character similar to any one of those located by article IX, section 12, or		
30	this section shall may be established or maintained without an amendment of this constitution.
