- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability 2 of implementing voter registration. 3 WHEREAS, North Dakota is the only state that does not require voter registration; and 4 WHEREAS, the reduction in the number of voting precincts has increased the number 5 of voters eligible to vote at each polling place, which may present greater opportunities for voter 6 fraud; and 7 WHEREAS, detailed study of the feasibility and desirability of implementing a voter 8 registration system may be necessary because the impacts of the federal motor voter 9 legislation are not fully known; 10 11
  - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
  - That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of implementing voter registration; and
- 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 16 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
