1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the public utility territorial 2 integrity laws of this state. 3 WHEREAS, proposed legislation has been introduced in the Congress of the United 4 States which would allow retail customers the ability to choose their electricity providers; and 5 WHEREAS, North Dakota's public utility laws govern which electric service providers 6 will serve which customers; and 7 WHEREAS, there is a national trend toward competition in the electric industry and this 8 competition may have potential benefits for electric consumers, suppliers, and the residents of 9 this state; and 10 WHEREAS, the electricity marketplace has changed since the Territorial Integrity Act 11 was enacted by the Legislative Assembly in 1965; and 12 WHEREAS, it may be in the best interests of the residents of this state to allow new 13 customers the ability to choose their provider of electric energy; and 14 WHEREAS, a study of North Dakota's current electric distribution extension laws to 15 provide for customer choice may be in the interests of the consumers in this state; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 17 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 18 That the Legislative Council study the public utility territorial integrity laws of this state; 19 and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 22 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
