1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the development of a strategic 2 planning process for the future of public health in this state. 3 WHEREAS, the well-being of the residents of this state relies on a strong, effective, and 4 efficient health care system; and 5 WHEREAS, health care costs are a concern of the Legislative Assembly and the 6 residents of this state; and 7 WHEREAS, public health has played a significant role in the improvement of the health 8 status of North Dakotans; and 9 WHEREAS, it is necessary to transform and strengthen public health in order to 10 respond to the challenges of the 21st century; and 11 WHEREAS, the Governor of this state has encouraged strategic planning for the future 12 of public health in this state; and 13 WHEREAS, this strategic plan should include local public health departments, health 14 care providers, academic institutions, and the public in order to construct a coordinated 15 approach for promoting long-term health and wellness in the residents of this state; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 17 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 18 That the Legislative Council study the development of a strategic planning process for 19 the future of public health in this state, and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 22 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
