- A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability of providing nursing services in the public schools of this state.

 WHEREAS, students in kindergarten through grade 12 frequently require the administration of pharmaceuticals during school hours; and

 WHEREAS, a significant number of special needs students require medical attention that is beyond the scope of training normally given to teachers and school district
- WHEREAS, all students and school district personnel are susceptible to unanticipated injuries and illnesses and could benefit from having prompt attention by trained medical personnel; and
 - **WHEREAS**, all students and school district personnel could benefit from the promotion of health and wellness concepts; and
- WHEREAS, the potential contribution of nurses to the health, safety, and welfare of this state's students and school district personnel has not been adequately examined;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of providing nursing services in the public schools of this state.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
