SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4044

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study ways of improving the filing of
2 agricultural liens so losses resulting from incomplete or inaccurate information can be reduced.

3 **WHEREAS**, the central filing system was designed to reduce the number of filings
4 required to gain a perfected security interest; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the central filing system was designed to provide easy and widespread
6 access to lien and security information; and

7 **WHEREAS**, losses are occasionally suffered when not all liens and security information
8 are accessed;

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
10 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

11 That the Legislative Council study ways of improving the filing of agricultural liens so
12 losses resulting from incomplete or inaccurate information can be reduced; and

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
14 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
15 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
